Members suggested fees ranging from \$75 for a standard application to \$300 for an application requiring a public hearing. Pine County charges a routine \$600 for a variance request. Chair Orvis requested board direction on this issue.

Chair Orvis called the next working commission meeting for 6:30 p.m., 11 October 2022, to continue discussions on the nonpermanent structure issues.
