## **Cleaner - Job Description**

Ensure exterior window cleaning specifically added in the duties to be performed semi-annually or as directed.

## Pine County Cannabis ordinance on Retail sales

Reviewed and determined acceptable as this is only for Retail. Further discussions will be required in reference to Royalton Townships concerns with cultivation and agriculture.

## **September 24 Planning Commission minutes**

Correction required on short-term rental ordinance. The commission is not close to completing, this reference should have been applied to the campground ordinance. Short-term rentals is still very much a work in process.

#### **Campground Discussion**

Reviewed final draft of the ordinance for proposal to the board. We agreed to add our site permit ordinance and local code page 15 Section 9 Building Requirements. Commission is proposing the board to approve and motion to pass the campground ordinance

#### **Building Permit Discussion**

Board approved the proposal to issue\_a formal notice to Rum River Consultants - Andy Schreder with a 60 day notice advising of the Township no longer needing their services. This is pending attorney review and hope to have feedback by next board meeting.

Commission is proposing the board to approve and motion to pass the removal of the MN Building Code requirements and proceed with 60 day notice.

#### **Further Discussions:**

Discussed the goal of completing the following by years end: Admin Citation ordinance - questioned whether we should call it an ordinance violation fee vs. Admin Citation. Jessica to reach out to Jeff on the attorney questions on fees. Still working on how to enforce

Also by year end ideally complete policy around Recording and cameras and security At the top of 2025 we'd like to dive into the short-term rentals, fire boundaries and the Township website facelift and domain to .gov
